Why menopause/HRT clinics?

- Menopause effects <u>ALL women</u>
- Average age of the menopause is 51yrs, average life expectancy is 82yrs, so 30% of life is postmenopausal
- Over 38 recognised symptoms of the menopause, low oestrogen wide ranging effects
- Education gap <u>menopause care can be improved</u>. Symptoms documented with menopause checker. Reduce repeat appointments, unnecessary investigations
- Many women refused HRT for wrong reasons
- If prescribed appropriately HRT benefits outweigh risks for majority of women
